Historical Events

The partnership of Councils are now delivering a touring exhibition and outreach programme based on the theme of our shared history and highlighting the Plantation of Ulster in this cluster area. This programme looks at our shared history as a tool to help people recognise that we have a common history and heritage, challenging existing attitudes and supporting conflict resolution and mediation.

Historical Events Programme Objectives:

- Raise awareness and improve factual understanding of the Plantation of Ulster in Derry, Strabane and Omagh.
- Increase the understanding of the significance of these events on the creation of modern Ulster.
- Create opportunities for cross community activities across this cluster area as a means of promoting cultural identity.
- Allow those who participate in this programme to share their views and contribute to raising awareness of the importance of this event in shaping our cultural identity.
- To dispel some of the myths and attitudes around Plantation and the image of the Planter and the Gael.
- Allow those participants to gain a greater understanding of the multi-cultural society we live in within the cluster area and at a community level.
